

Forms and Document Outputs

- Thesis Proposal Form (TPF): The TPF is an electronic record of the proposal approval, initiated by the student and signed in Python by all required parties.
- **First 8 Pages:** The First 8 pages are literally the first 8 pages of the thesis. They contain the cover, thesis title and abstract, author and advisor information, and distribution statement, all pulled from the metadata in the Python Thesis Dashboard.
- Thesis Release and Approval Form (TRAF): The TRAF is an electronic record of the thesis approval, initiated by the student and signed in Python by all required parties.

Data

- Data in Python include student name(s), advisory team, thesis title and abstract, and distribution statement. These are inputted into the dashboard and outputted in First 8 pages.
- Other data are collected, tracked, stored, and used in announcements. This includes compliance tasks, keywords, and relevancy topics.

Dates

- Milestones: The milestones include sequential required tasks as well as their respective due dates and dates completed
- Estimated departure date (EDD): The EDD is the date the student must detach from NPS; students update their EDD as orders come in and due dates adjust accordingly.

- Advisor-Chair Review Files folder:
 Protocol varies by department. In this folder,
 students may share thesis drafts with their
 advisory team as well as upload First 8 pages
 and thesis documents for approver review.
- For Thesis Processing Office folder: Use to share files with the Thesis Processing Office. Upload First 8 pages and body of thesis for reviews. Processor will use this folder exclusively to share completed Initial and Final Reviews and edited First 8 pages with students.
